We're also interested in getting a sense of your experience and artistic voice. You'll have the opportunity to share past directing or assistant directing work, along with the strengths and perspectives you bring to the process. We'd love to know what kinds of stories or themes you're most passionate about, and how your work supports Gallery Theater's commitment to inclusivity and community engagement.

If you're proposing a specific show, we'll ask for key details like the title, playwright, and preferred performance space, along with your vision for why the piece fits our audience and season. You'll be able to describe your general artistic approach, any creative concepts or challenges you anticipate, and the overall scale of your production needs—from set and costumes to sound and lighting. Musical proposals will also include a few quick questions about your preferred music setup.

If you're applying without a specific show in mind, you'll be able to tell us what types of productions you'd be excited to direct, any preferences you have around plays or musicals, and whether you lean toward a particular space. This helps us make strong pairings as we build the season.

At the end of the form, there's space for any additional thoughts, creative ideas, or information you'd like to share. We look forward to hearing your voice and vision.
